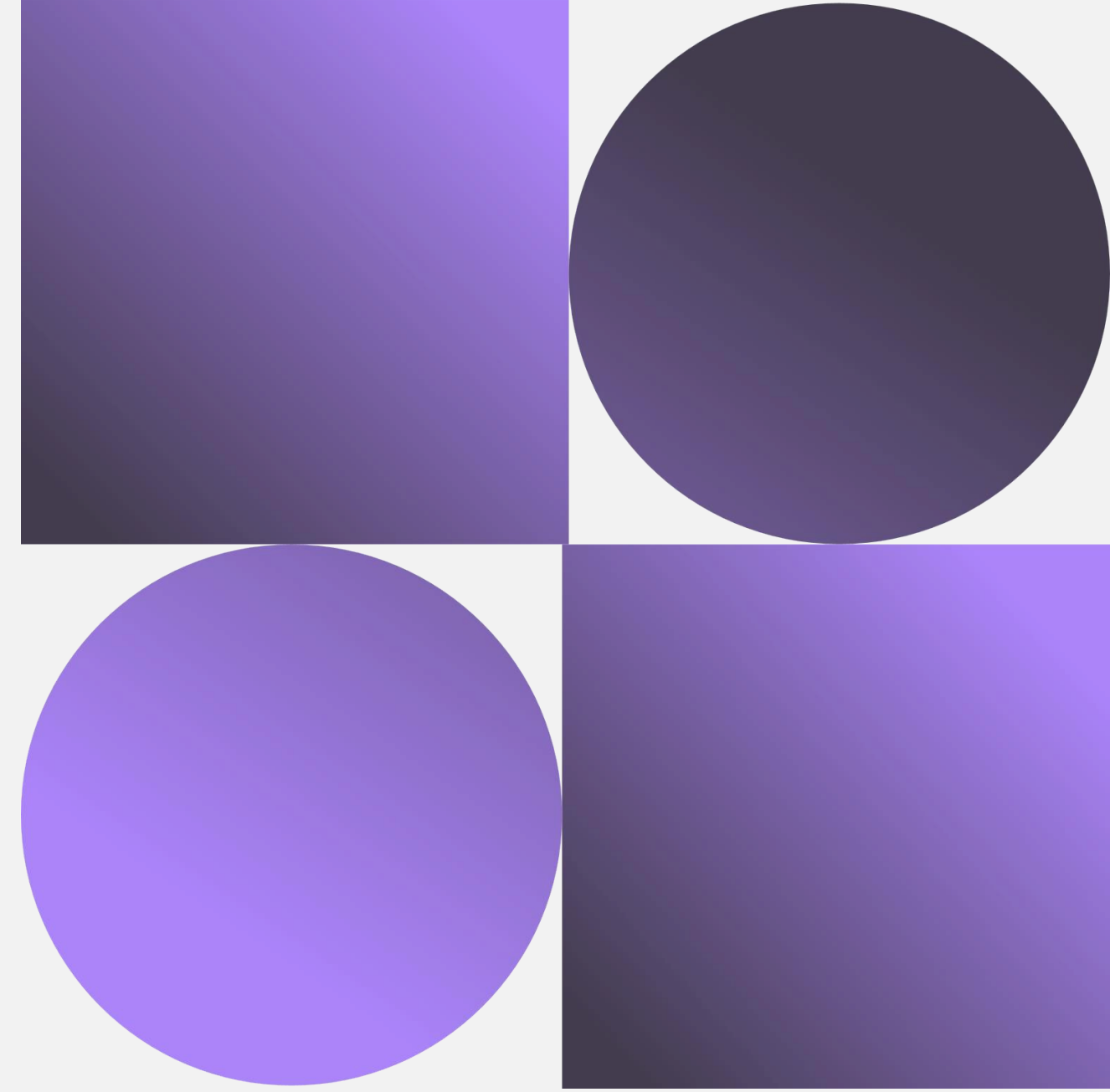




ADE Sign-in Updates for Adobe ID users

April 2026



PURPOSE

Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) is a consumer eBook reading app that has historically used Adobe ID for user login. ByteBooks, operated by Wipro, has now taken full responsibility for running the Adobe eBook platform, including managing user accounts and handling eBook licenses.



What is changing ?

- ADE will now use ByteBooks for sign-in
- Hence, you'll need to create a new ByteBooks account
- **The change is planned to take effect by End of May 2026**

What is not changing ?

- Your eBook library and reading licenses remain unchanged
- Your email address remains the same as before
- Adobe Digital Editions app remains the same
- Your borrowing or purchase history will be retained as this is linked against your email address

What's the purpose of this document ?

- Provides a step-by-step guide for the users to create ByteBooks ID and reset the password on ByteBooks
- This is **one time process** that users need to perform



How do I know if it affects me ?

It affects you

If you are an 'EXISTING ADE USER' and -

- You open "Computer Authorization" page of ADE
- Enter your regular Adobe ID & password
- But you see some error and cannot log in
 - Please go to [page 4](#) of this document to get further guidance

Or

If you are a 'NEW ADE USER' and –

- You are setting up Adobe Digital Editions on a new device
 - Please go to [page 11](#) of this document to get further guidance

It may not affect you immediately if -

- You are already logged-in to Adobe Digital Editions
- You are continuing to read as usual

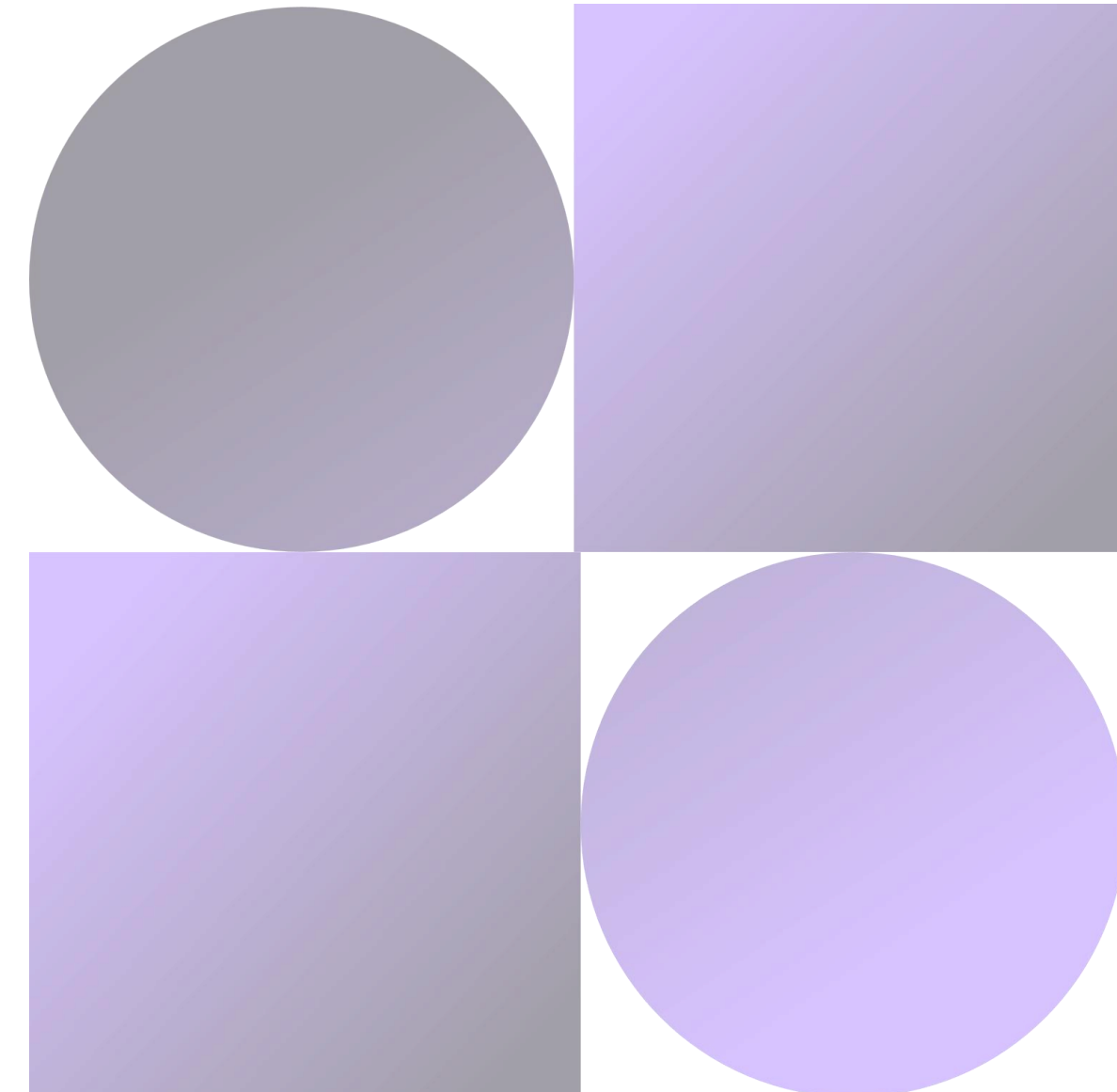
But it will affect next time you try to sign in to ADE

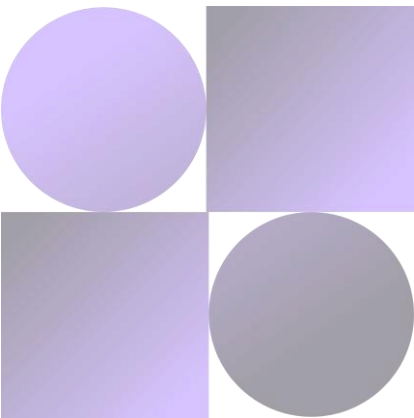

What do I do now ?

Just follow the below 4 step process and you'll be done

1. Open the Transition Page on Adobe's website.
2. Follow the redirection. Land on the ByteBooks website. Create a new ID.
3. Verify your e-mail via OTP-based Authentication.
4. Re-sign into ADE using your ByteBooks ID.

Let's do it one by one....



Step 1

Open the transition page on Adobe's Website

1. This will open the “*Transition of Adobe eBook platform to WCS – FAQ*” page
2. Click on the **ByteBooks Account Creation** button at the bottom.
3. This will open the ByteBooks website.
4. Create your **ByteBooks account**.



Step 2

Land on the ByteBooks website. Create a new ID

- Enter details – First Name, Last Name, Password etc.
 - **Critical:** You must use the same email address associated with your Adobe ID. This is how your existing eBook licenses are identified and linked to your new ByteBooks account. Using a different email address means your previously licensed eBooks won't be recognized.
- Ticking the “**I have an existing Adobe eBooks to migrate**” checkbox and using the same Adobe ID email ensures your existing eBook licenses are linked to your new ByteBooks account. Some eBooks may appear in your library automatically; others may need to be re-downloaded from your library or store when you're ready to read them.
- Click on the **Send OTP** button.
- You'll receive an OTP(One Time password) on the email address you have entered

Step 3

Verify your Email



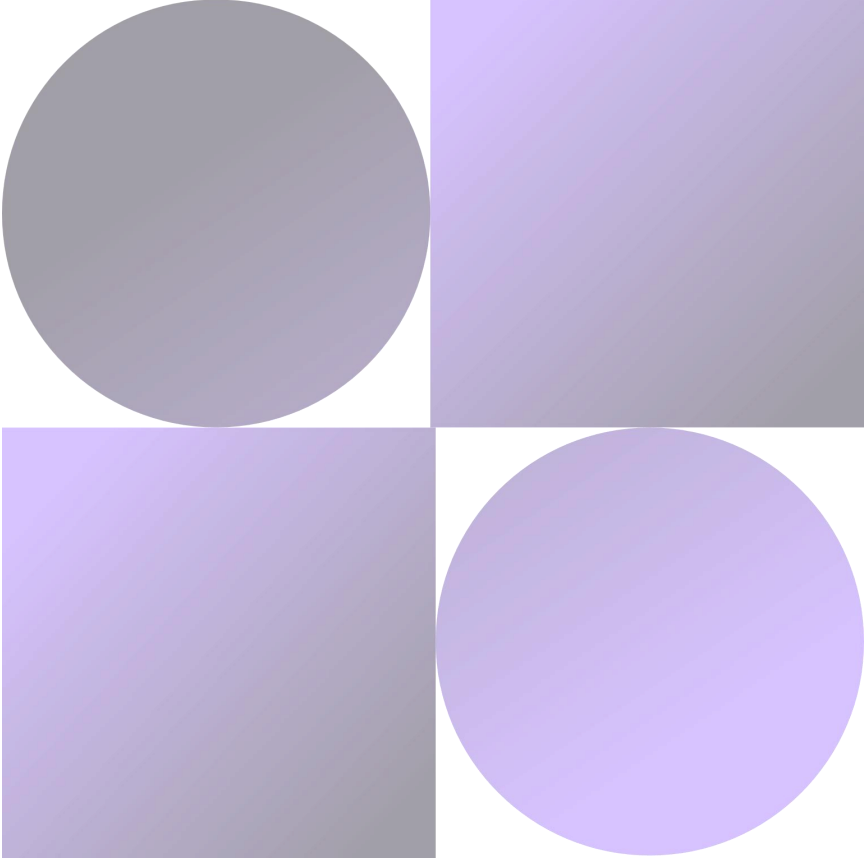

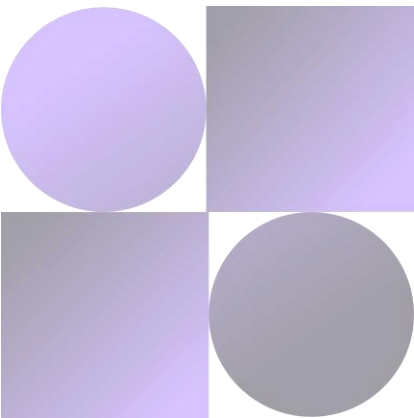

4. Sign back into Adobe Digital Editions using ByteBooks ID.

Step 1

Open the transition page on Adobe's Website


1. This will open the “*Transition of Adobe eBook platform to WCS – FAQ*” page.



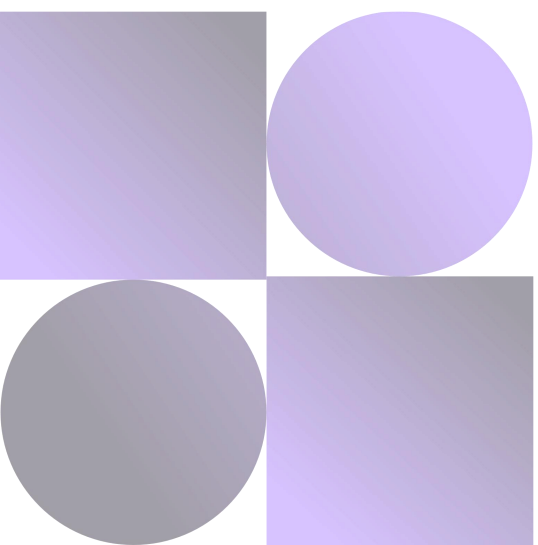
